

## Classes of 2019, 2020 \& 2021

- For the Class of 2019, the overall response rate for the survey was $25 \%$ (65 valid responses/ 264 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was $24 \%$ (53 valid responses/ 218 valid e-mail addresses).
- For the Class of 2020, the overall response rate for the survey was $22 \%$ (64 valid responses/ 293 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was $23 \%$ ( 58 valid responses/ 248 valid e-mail addresses).
- For the Class of 2021, the overall response rate for the survey was $21 \%$ ( 55 valid responses/258 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was $21 \%$ (46 valid responses/218 valid e-mail addresses).
