

Classes of 2019, 2020 & 2021

- For the Class of 2019, the overall response rate for the survey was 25% (65 valid responses/264 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was 24% (53 valid responses/218 valid e-mail addresses).
- For the Class of 2020, the overall response rate for the survey was 22% (64 valid responses/293 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was 23% (58 valid responses/248 valid e-mail addresses).
- For the Class of 2021, the overall response rate for the survey was 21% (55 valid responses/258 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was 21% (46 valid responses/218 valid e-mail addresses).





For those employed, do you consider yourself employed in an area related to your course of study? (N =143)




For those employed, did your position change as a result of completing your degree? (N =142)




Are you currently pursuing additional education? (N =151)




If not pursuing education, intend to attend school in the future? (N = 135)
